APPLICATION FOR HORSE REGISTRATION

Please read these rules carefully BEFORE completing the application form. Any incomplete or incorrect forms will be returned. Horse owners MUST be current financial members of the CCSHA, in order to register horses.

Please don't forget to specify which type of registration you are applying for and complete the appropriate sections of the *Registration Form*. Ensure that all appropriate certificates are supplied. Incomplete applications will be returned.

IMPORTANT NOTES: Registration applications can be made and paid for online; please visit our website and follow the links. If you register your horse online, the Association will waive the processing fee, making registering both cheaper and easier.

REGISTRATIONS WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PROOF OF CLYDESDALE HERITAGE AND / OR BY UNDERGOING CLASSIFICATION BY THE CCSHA COMMITTEE. PLEASE SEE BELOW FOR FURTHER DETAILS.

A. GENERAL RULES

- · Please use a separate form for each horse registration
- Only horses which are PART Clydesdale may be registered with the CCSHA, full / purebred Clydesdale horses are not eligible for registration
- For the purposes of registration, the height of your horse refers to 'adult' horses (i.e. 5 years and over). If you horse is under 5 years of age, please write N/A
- The registration of horses with the CCSHA is for life; however the current owner(s) must remain a financial member. If the current owner's membership lapses, the registration shall be suspended
- The initial and continuing registration of the horse is dependent upon the owner remaining a financial member of the CCSHA. All named owners or part owners MUST be members of the CCSHA. If the owner(s) are not currently members of the CCSHA, this form must be accompanied by an application for membership
- Horses may only be registered once with the Association. Please complete a Horse Registration Transfer Form if you have purchased a Clydesdale Cross that has previously been registered with the CCSHA
- A horse's registered name can only be changed through a special application, via the CCSHA Committee. Changes involving another
 member's stud prefix will not be allowed under any circumstances. Requests should be made by contacting the Registrar at
 registrar@ccsha.com
- In order to protect the privacy of all parties involved, Breeder's names cannot be included on registration certificates without their written authorisation

B. NAMES

- If the name you have chosen is already registered, you will be contacted via email and asked to choose an alternative name
- The CCSHA accepts registration of Stud Prefixes / Suffixes. A separate form is available for the registration of your stud prefix / suffix. If a prefix / suffix is already registered, you may not incorporate this prefix / suffix into your name, unless you have proof the horse was bred by the Stud in question and have written permission from the breeder
- The addition of numbers to a name already in use is not allowed (e.g. If Stolichnaya is currently registered; you cannot register Stolichnaya 2 or Stolichnaya II). Addition of "The" to the beginning of a name already in use is also not allowed

C. DESCRIPTION AND IDENTIFICATION OF HORSES

- All Stud Book horses MUST be either branded or microchipped
- When completing your application, you are required to provide hand drawn diagrams of white markings / whorls / scars in the applicable section of the *Registration Form*.

- All excessively marked horses (e.g. sabino, roan, pinto, appaloosa, etc.) may provide <u>three (3)</u> photos of the horse, in place of a hand-drawn diagram. These will be kept on file, with the horse's registration application. Photos must clearly show;
 - 1. The head and forelegs
 - 2. The near side
 - 3. The off side
- All known information and names of the horse's pedigree (i.e. sire, dam, grandsire, granddam), are to be included on the Registration Form
- If a horse in the pedigree is registered with another breed association / society, a copy of the certificate must be submitted with this application in order for registration details (e.g. registration numbers, breed society names, etc.) to be included on the CCSHA certificate. If certificates are not enclosed, registration details will not be included

D. REGISTRATION TYPES AND FEES

1. Stud Book Registration

- Mares and stallions with a minimum of 25% registered Clydesdale in their pedigree (i.e. at least one grand(sire)/grand(dam) is a REGISTERED Clydesdale)
- Mares and stallions upgraded from the Sport Horse Register due to special merit (a separate application form is available for request to upgrade)
- Fillies and colts under 2 years of age may be recorded as foals OR accepted into the adult / permanent Stud Book register
- ALL new stallion applications or upgrades from Foal Recordings MUST include a Certificate of Breeding Soundness from a registered Veterinarian and must undergo Classification by the CCSHA Committee. Please refer to the Classification section so you are aware of the evidence you are required to supply
- Proof of registered Clydesdale parentage must be submitted with this application (e.g. service certificate from a registered Clydesdale stallion, CCSHA service certificate, copy of CCHS / CCSHA registration papers, etc.)

2. Sport Horse Registration

- Fillies / mares and colts / stallions / geldings of any age
- Horses under 2 years of age may be recorded as foals OR accepted into the adult / permanent Sport Horse register
- Progeny of CCSHA registered horses (e.g. Stud Book progeny that are not 25% and / or are geldings, progeny of registered Sport Horses, etc.)
- Horse owners must provide at least 2 forms of proof that the horse is part Clydesdale OR must undergo Classification by the CCSHA Committee (see over for details)
- Stallions without proven Clydesdale heritage are NOT eligible for registration with the CCSHA
- ALL new stallion applications or upgrades from Foal Recordings (with proven Clydesdale heritage) MUST include a Certificate of Breeding Soundness from a registered Veterinarian and must undergo Classification by the CCSHA Committee. Please refer to the Classification section so you are aware of the evidence you are required to supply

3. Foal Recording

- Fillies / colts / geldings under 2 years of age
- Horses under 2 years of age may be recorded as foals OR registered in the adult / permanent register
- Once a horse reaches 2 years of age, they must be upgraded into the adult / permanent register. If an application to upgrade is not received by the time the horse is 3 years of age, registration will be cancelled and a new application will be required
- Stud Book Foal Recordings must meet same the criteria outlined in the Stud Book Registration section
- Sport Horse Foal Recordings must meet same the criteria outlined in the Sport Horse Registration section

E. SUPPLYING PROOF OF CLYDESDALE HERITAGE

As of 01.02.16, applications for Sport Horse registration, including Foal Recordings, will be categorised according to the following criteria;

- 1. Horses with proof / evidence of Clydesdale heritage
- 2. Horses with no proof / evidence of Clydesdale heritage

If you do not have proof / evidence but genuinely believe that your horse is part Clydesdale, your application will need to undergo Classification by the CCSHA Committee (see below for details).

Acceptable forms of evidence / proof may include but are not limited to:

- Service certificates from a registered Clydesdale stallion or Clydesdale Cross stallion
- Copy of the sire / dam / granddam / grandsire's registration papers
- Letter / written statement from the breeder or previous owner
- Statutory Declaration
- Written statement from a registered Veterinarian
- Photographs / video of sire / dam
- Copies of certificates of registration from other breed societies showing Clydesdale heritage
- Receipt of sale or copy of advertisement showing Clydesdale heritage

F. CLASSIFICATION

As of 01.02.16, ALL registration applications for the following horses MUST undergo Classification by the CCSHA Committee (or sub-committee):

- 1. Stallions over 2 years of age
- 2. Sport Horses (including Sport Horse Foal Recordings) where there is no proof / evidence of Clydesdale heritage

The aims of the Classification process are to confirm that the stallion is of breeding quality, verify the claims made by the horse owner and to determine if the horse exhibits true Clydesdale Cross traits / characteristics. If your horse is required to undergo Classification, you will need to complete an Application for Classification (as well as this registration form) and provide a series of photographs that clearly show the confirmation of your horse (e.g. a full view of both sides, front and rear). To assist with the Classification process, a short video of your horse at a walk, trot and canter is also recommended.

Photographs / video must be in colour, of good quality and clearly illustrate the Clydesdale Cross characteristics of the horse. Dark, blurry or unsuitable photographs / video footage will be returned and applications will be denied. Evidence can be sent via:


- Email please do not send videos via email and ensure that your photos do not exceed 10MB
- · Saved on a disc or USB and sent via post
- Photographs can also be printed and sent via the post

NOTE: The CCSHA Committee reserve the right to review any and all registration applications via the Classification process

MARKING TERMINOLOGY

White Head Markings

Star: Any white marking on the forehead Stripe: Narrow white marking running down nose Snip: White marking in vicinity of nostrils Blaze: Wide white marking covering most of face

White Leg Markings

Please be specific about the location of any white leg markings (e.g. white to coronet / fetlock / above or below knee)

Brands

Any brand is acceptable. Some common descriptors for brands include:

Lazy: Letter or number on their side Conjoined: Two letters or numbers joined together

Script: Cursive letter Over: When one letter or number, is placed over another
