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PERFORMANCE AWARD CRITERIA

1. Performance Award points are attributed to each registered horse, irrespective of their handler / rider. For example: If a registered horse is shown by one member and show jumped by another member, points accumulated by BOTH competitors will count towards the horse's Performance Award
2. Only current CCSHA members and CCSHA registered horse combinations are eligible for the CCSHA Performance Award
3. Horses must be registered before the commencement of accumulating points and each rider / handler must remain a member for the duration of points accumulation
4. Horses are required to accrue 500 points in order to be awarded a Woollen Saddle Blanket and 1000 points in order to be awarded a cotton rug
5. Points will not be accepted unless they have been signed off by an Event Official / Hosting Club Official / CCSHA Executive member and back-dating of records is NOT permitted
6. The Performance Award will only be awarded after the CCSHA Awards Secretary receives and verifies, the correctly completed Performance records
7. There is no time limit on the accumulation of Performance Award points; however each horse is eligible for only ONE 500 Point Performance Award and ONE 1000 Point Performance Award
8. CCSHA members are responsible for the completion of all Performance records.
9. Performance Award records must be PRINTED neatly; illegible records will not be accepted
10. Records will not be accepted with "white out" corrections
11. Before presenting your Performance record to the Event Official for signing, please complete the event details
12. If rider / competitor is UNPLACED at the event, please write UNPLACED in the placing section.
13. One class or event should be listed in each record spacing (e.g. 2 dressage tests will use 2 event record spaces and 3 dressage tests , will use 3 spaces)
14. Events directly organised by the CCSHA, as well as State and National titles in any equestrian discipline, will receive DOUBLE event attendance points
15. Where an event is made up of more than one equestrian activity (e.g. horse trials and combined training), **ONLY** the whole event is eligible for points
16. For dressage, each test placing can be counted towards the Performance Award; no extra points are awarded for Jackpot placing
17. In the equestrian discipline of showing, event points will be awarded for attendance at the event but placing points will only be counted for Supreme, Champion, Reserve Champion and 1st – 3rd placing
18. The CCSHA Committee reserve the right to refuse applicants and adjust criteria at any time
19. The CCSHA Committee reserve the right to award the Performance Award to a CCSHA member who has shown remarkable persistence, patience and devotion to the CCSHA and or the Clydesdale Cross Sport Horse
20. Performance Award files will be maintained by the Performance Award Manager and published regularly on the CCSHA website and Newsletter
21. The CCSHA recommends that members keep completed forms in a secure place and copies should be made of ALL submitted records (either digital or hard copy). Completed forms that are lost, can NOT be reproduced. Members are welcome to submit copies of their completed forms to our CCSHA Awards Secretary on website@ccsha.com

23. Please contact the Performance Award Manager for instructions, if Performance Award records are lost or stolen
24. If members are found to be falsely recording points, forging event secretary's signatures and / or being deceitful about any information contained on their Performance Award paperwork, they will be subject to disciplinary action. This may include having their membership cancelled and / or being banned from participating in the Performance Award scheme



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PERFORMANCE AWARD POINTS SCALE

The primary goal of the Clydesdale Cross Sport Horse Association Performance Award, is to encourage and recognise Clydesdale Cross Sport horses and their owner / riders, in all forms of equestrian activity and competition. It is designed to encourage and reward CCSHA members who own registered Clydesdale Cross Sport horses to participate in equestrian sports and events.

The Clydesdale Cross Sport Horse is extremely versatile, members and their horses participate in a wide range of equestrian activities and the committee believes the horses should be recognised for their skills and achievements. The award will be conferred using a points system for all events attended, with extra points for placing. Double event attendance points will be awarded for events directly run by the CCSHA. Double event and placing points will also be awarded to any combination that competes at State and National level competitions. If you are attending an event that is not listed below, please contact the Award Secretary (secretary@ccsha.com) to negotiate the associated points.

Once a horse accrues 500 POINTS (and those points are verified by the CCSHA Committee), it will be awarded with a beautiful woollen saddle cloth (black with gold and white trim), featuring the CCSHA Performance Award logo. Once a horse accrues 1000 POINTS (and those points are verified by the CCSHA Committee), it will be awarded with a beautiful cotton rug (black with gold and white trim), featuring the CCSHA Performance Award logo.
