RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MEMBERS

The CCSHA is an Association Incorporated in Victoria (Association No. A0046657H) and as such, is governed by the rules and regulations laid down in the Associations Incorporation Act 1981 (section 7). A copy of the rules can be obtained by writing to the Secretary at the address above or by visiting the Consumer Affairs Victoria website (www.consumer.vic.gov.au).

In addition to the rules governing the running of the Association, we have the following regulations governing the registration of horses, eligibility for CCSHA prizes at events and voting at meetings.

- Horses registered by the CCSHA are registered for the lifetime of the horse upon payment of the prescribed fee. However, continued registration is dependent upon the owner of the horse being a current financial member of the Association. If the owner's membership lapses, the registration of the horse shall be suspended until such time as membership is resumed
- 2. To be eligible for CCSHA sponsored prizes, the horse must be a horse registered with the CCSHA and the rider must be a current financial member of the CCSHA
- 3. Junior members are not eligible to vote at either Annual General Meetings or Special General Meetings, nor may they be members of the Committee. Junior members are defined as members 18 years of age and under.
- 4. Associate members must be nominated by a current, financial, adult member and are not eligible to vote at either Annual General Meetings or Special General Meetings. They may not be members of the Committee and are not able to register a horse or stud prefix / suffix.

All of the above rules (with the exception of those laid down under the Associations Incorporation Act) may be changed or temporarily suspended by the Committee.
