

The CCSHA invites all Clydesdale Cross and heavy horse owners, to take part in our 2021 Young Stock and Heavy Horse Show. To celebrate the diversity of the Clydesdale Cross and other heavy horse breeds, the CCSHA is hosting Young Stock classes for yearlings to 3 year olds, as well as great program for adult heavy breeds.

Like all CCSHA events, we offer a relaxed and supportive environment that caters for complete beginners, right through to experienced show handlers. It does not matter if you and your horse have never competed before; there will be plenty of assistance on the day and people to cheer you on.

There will be a range of heavy horse breeds attending the show, many of which are traditionally shown unplaited, unclipped and full-feathered. For those with senior horses, please feel free to go all out in your turnout gear or bring your horse with mane, tail and feather flying.

Catering will be available on the day and well-priced camping and stables are available onsite for those who wish to stay over.

Competitors **MUST** be current financial members of their own breed society and horses **MUST** be registered. <u>Proof must be provided with your entry form, or your entries will not be accepted.</u> Classes may be combined / divided at the discretion of Event Officials.

Young Stock MUST be 3 years of age and under, as determined by the 01.08.21.

Entries are charged at \$8.00 per class.

Facility fee of \$12.50 per horse is charged by the venue.

ENTRIES AND ADDITIONAL CLASSES ARE NOT AVAILABLE ON THE DAY

This is a COVID-safe event. Failure to comply with the COVID-19 rules may result in elimination, removal from the grounds, and exclusion from future CCSHA events.

Pre-entries are welcomed until midnight on Sunday 14th November. Entries received after this date will be subject to a \$20 late fee. No entries will be accepted after midnight on Wednesday 17th November

GUIDELINES AND RULES FOR COMPETITORS

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Competitors MUST be current financial members of your society and horses MUST be registered with that society. A copy of your membership card (or similar), as well as your horse's registration certificate, MUST be sent in with all entries.
- CCSHA events are dog-free zones, so please leave your pets at home
- Entries are NOT available on the day. All entries must be received by midnight on Sunday 14th November
- CCSHA Membership and Horse Registrations must be completed prior to the Event and will NOT be accepted on the day
- A First Aid representative will be on hand during the Event for any accidents or injuries that may occur
- Please respect the grounds, clean up after yourself and follow Elmore Equestrian Park's guidelines for rubbish and manure disposal
- Show entries that have not been paid in full, will not be accepted
- NO SMOKING IN VENUE OR AROUND ENTRANCE TO VENUE
- Competitors may enter the venue through Rosaia 4 Gate (fourth) gate in Rosaia Road from Midland Highway
- CCSHA registered horses are eligible to accumulate Performance Award and Annual High Point Award Points. Please ensure that you bring your Performance Award form and High Point cards so the Event Secretary can sign them on the day
- A professional photographer will be present at the Event and competitors will be provided with the
 opportunity to purchase photographs directly from the supplier. CCSHA representatives will also be taking
 photographs on the day which may be displayed on the CCSHA Facebook page or website
- All horse owners are required to provide a Property Identification Code (PIC) relating to the property where the horse is kept.
- In the case of adverse weather or any unforeseen circumstances, the Committee Reserve the right to alter the program and / or postpone or cancel the Event
- Entry fees are ONLY refundable in extenuating circumstances (e.g. injuries or illness). Competitors may
 apply for a refund in writing (<u>secretary@ccsha.com</u>) and MUST supply a medical or veterinary certificate
 to substantiate their claim. An administration fee of \$10 will be payable by riders / handlers applying for a
 refund

COVID RELATED RULES

- All competitors and essential helpers and required to sign in using the QR code or manual register
- As we are running a COVID-safe event the approach of 'get in, compete, get out', minimising unnecessary
 contact at the event, will be in place. The protocol of only the minimum personnel required to attend the event
 also remains, so please limit the number of spectators/helpers you bring along

- Please practice good hand washing protocols and use sanitiser, particularly when accessing shared areas such as wash bays
- Please observe signage around the grounds, including any density limits that may apply
- The sharing of equipment is not permitted. Please ensure you brings your own hose, buckets, stable rake, feed tubs, pooper scoopers, etc.
- Persons displaying any symptoms must not attend or be permitted on site and persons displaying any symptoms, after arrival, must depart the site immediately
- Physical distancing (1.5m) must be maintained in all areas
- Face masks are no longer mandatory at outdoor community sport; however they are still highly recommended, particularly when social distancing is not possible. All participants should carry their mask at all times (unless for a lawful reason)
- The Victorian Government's Roadmap states that only those with a double vaccination will be permitted to
 attend events. There has been no directive issued to the CCSHA regarding this to date and we will keep
 participants informed as news comes to hand

CAMPING AND ACCOMMODATION

- Camping MUST be booked with and fees paid directly to Elmore Equestrian Park (EEP) via the Nominate
 website (https://www.nominate.com.au/Stables/VenueIntroduction.aspx?vid=411). The CCSHA is unable
 to accept fees or make bookings on your behalf.
- Horse manure in camping area MUST be cleaned up

STABLES

- Stables MUST be booked with and fees paid directly to EEP. via the Nominate website
 (https://www.nominate.com.au/Stables/VenueIntroduction.aspx?vid=411). The CCSHA is unable to accept fees or make bookings on your behalf.
- Stables are undercover (3.3m x 3.3m) the stable next to your horse may be booked to use as a tack room (pending availability)
- Yards are available at no charge. They are not undercover. Bookings are not required
- Competitors will be advised of their allocated stable numbers prior to the event and are not permitted to swap stables without permission from EEP
- All stables must be thoroughly cleaned before you leave. Stables that have not been cleaned correctly will incur a fee
- Painting of horse's hooves is strictly not permitted on any concreted areas, including the stables. There are mats available in the stable pavilion for competitors use
- Competitors who have not booked stables are required to park their float in the day yard area

RULES FOR HORSES

- ALL horses must be registered with relevant breed societies and copies of registrations MUST be provided with entry forms
- In order to the eligible to enter Young Stock classes, horses MUST be 3 years of age and under, as at 01.08.21
- Horses will be allocated with an exhibit number and this must be clearly displayed throughout the event (i.e. chest number holder, number displayed on halter / bridle, handler to wear number, etc.)
- Young stock must be weaned and / or compete in the ring on their own. No Mares or other companions
 may enter the ring
- Young stock to be shown according to their breed standard
- Plaiting is optional. All horses should be presented in a neat, clean and tidy manner
- Under no circumstances are horses to be tied to the rails of the arena
- Horses that are deemed to be risk to other exhibits or exhibitors will be asked to leave the arena and no refund on entries will be provided
- Horse food or water is NOT permitted in the arena
- No lunging is permitted on any grass area
- Wash bays are available for use (cold water only) and must be kept clean at all times. Please ensure you
 remove any manure and be respectful of other competitors

Stallions

- Colts under 2 years of age are NOT permitted to be handled by those under the age of 15 years
- Stallions / colts 2 years & over, MUST be handled and ridden by a person over 18 years and over and
 must be bitted at all time while in the arena / ring
- Stallions should wear official green 'discs' at all times whilst at the venue. These discs are to be worn on both sides of head collars and bridles or on some part of the horse on both sides to identify to others that the horse is a stallion
- Colts / stallions must be under effective control AT ALL TIMES. Any colt / stallion that presents a danger
 to other horses or people, will be disqualified from the Event and may be asked to leave the premises
- All stallions must be suitably restrained while at floats. They may be double tied (with a suitable headstall, neck collar and 2 lead ropes), hobbled and tied up or contained in a stable
- Stallions must wear a headstall at all times when not bridled (i.e. when stabled). This ensures that your horse can easily be caught, should it escape

RULES FOR COMPETITORS

- Competitors must be current financial members of relevant breed societies and copies of membership cards (or similar proof) MUST be provided with entry forms
- All competitors compete at their own risk

- All competitors who are NOT current financial members of Equestrian Australia MUST sign the Waiver attached
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone that is suspected of being under the influence of Drugs or Alcohol
- The Judge's decision will be final and Judges must not be approached on the day of the show by competitors or their associates
- No exhibitor may show:
 - An exhibit bred by or leased from the judge or their family in the ring which the judge is
 officiating
 - An exhibit purchased from the judge or their family in the ring in which the judge is officiating, until after a period of 12 months
 - An exhibit in a class under the judge who has produced an animal for that exhibitor in the previous 12 months
- Once a class has commenced, no exhibit may leave the ring unless instructed to do so by the ring officials
- There is to be no change of handler once the class has commenced, without the permission of the Judge
- All competitors must wear suitable footwear and clothing. No open toe shoes or ripped clothes allowed
- Competitors who fail to abide by these rules will be asked the leave the ring / event
- Bad sportsmanship and bullying will not be tolerated by the CCSHA and may result in disciplinary action (e.g. being asked to leave the ring, disgualification from the event, cancellation of membership)

Protests

- An exhibitor / competitor may protest against an award won by an exhibitor / competitor in the same class alleging infringement of the rules or ineligibility
- Protests must be made in writing and lodged with the Event Secretary, within 30 minutes after the conclusion of the class
- Such protest shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50, which may be forfeited to the CCSHA if the
 protest is found to be unfounded or frivolous
- Protests will be considered by CCSHA / Event Officials and the decision shall be final

Junior Competitors

- All competitors under the age of 12 years must wear approved helmets (AS/NZS 3838, EN1384, ASTN F1163) when participating in led and long reining classes
- All handlers under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult while in the ring
- All handlers between 10 and 13 years must have a supervising adult present at the side of the ring who is
 able to assist, should they need help / get into trouble
- The Committee Reserve the right to request direct parental / adult supervision should they deem it necessary
